ELIGIBILITY

You are welcome to enter if you are a resident of Martin, St Lucie, Palm Beach, or Okeechobee Counties.

Must be 8 Years old or older.

Age: Youth: 8-12 yrs

Adult: 13+ yrs

DIVISION AWARDS GIVEN FOR EACH AGE GROUP

1st Place/Blue Ribbon \$8

2nd Place/Red Ribbon \$4

3rd Place/White Ribbon \$ 2

JUDGING

Each entry will be judged fairly on its own merit, using the Danish Judging System.

Judging is done by the most qualified judges available

The names of exhibitors are concealed during judging. The entry of only one item in a division does not necessarily guarantee the top award for that entry.

No one other than judges and committee members will be allowed to remain in the building during judging.

Flower Arrangements can be in up to 1 gallon container.
